## How to get there ?

There are plenty of ways to get there from both Germany and Denmark. Ferries from Kiel and Copenhagen to Oslo and about 8 hours drive from Oslo. From Kiel its Colorline and from Copenhagen its DFDS.

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You can take a ferry from Hirtshals to Kristiansand, or Stavanger or Bergen with Fjordline. From Kristiansand to Stranda its about 11 hours to drive. From Stavanger its about the same. From Bergen its about 7 hours to ride.

Of course its also the possibility to arrive by plane to Ålesund airport Vigra. And then its about two hours from there to the meeting.

## A little about everything else.

Stranda is a small village with about 2800 inhabitants. Koie Camping is located just outside the town and its a short walk to centre. Stranda is surrounded by high mountains and the fjord Storfjorden. And there is so much to see in this area.

The most famous places are:

Geiranger: In the end of Geirangerfjorden is Geiranger. Spectacular small village surrounded by the mountains. On the way you can stop at Dalsnibba and Ørnesvingen wich have really spectacular view of the place.
